Residential Electric Rate Schedule

Availability

This Schedule is available when electric service used for domestic purposes in and about a residential house, or in a separately metered individual apartment, including electric service used on a farm and in the preparation of the farm's products for market. A residential house served hereunder may be used as a boarding house, fraternity house, tourist home, or like establishment, provided such residential house is one which ordinarily would be used as a private residence.

Service under this Schedule is not available for processing (or handling) for marketing of farm products produced by others, for separately metered farm operations, for individual motors in excess of 10 hp (except as provided below), for highly seasonal heating load in excess of 10 kilowatts connected for commercial or industrial purposes, or for breakdown standby, supplementary, or resale services.

Applicability

This Schedule is applicable to all electric service of the same available type supplied to Customer's premises at one point of delivery through one kilowatt-hour meter.

Types of Service

The types of service to which this Schedule is applicable are alternating current, 60 cycle, either single-phase 2 or 3 wires, or three-phase 4 wires at the Town's standard voltage of 240 volts or less.

Monthly Rate

Single-Phase Service:

Monthly Customer Charge \$7.35

Energy Charge:

For the first 800 kWh \$0.12582 per kWh

All additional kWh \$0.11773 per kWh

Three-Phase Service:

Add an additional charge of \$7.75

** 3% North Carolina Utility Sales Tax will be added to the total charge under this schedule.*

Multiple Dwelling Units

When more than one residential house, or more than one housekeeping unit in a residential house, is served through the same meter, the \$7.35 in the minimum bill and the kWh in each energy blocks will be multiplied by the number of individuals dwelling units served.

Individual Motors

Service to individual motors rated more than 10 HP will not normally be permitted under this Schedule.

Payments

Bills are due when rendered and are payable on the 15th of the month. Any bills not paid by 5:00 p.m. on the 15th of the month, will accrue a \$5.00 or 1% penalty, whichever is greatest. Any bill not paid in full by 5:00 p.m. on the 20th of the month, is subject to disconnection of service.

General

Service rendered under this Schedule is subject of the provisions of the Rules and Regulations of the Town of Louisburg, NC.
